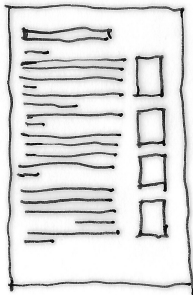


Underground London - Timeline Activity

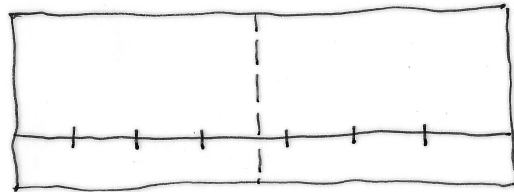
This is an activity for one person, or for a group, and focuses on the main dates in the development of underground London.

You will need either a long piece of paper or card, or you can tape several pieces together, plus scissors, glue and coloured pencils.

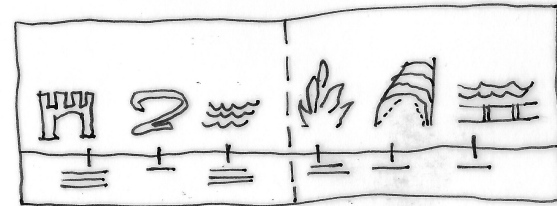

How to construct your timeline

Print out the Timeline of Underground London (black and white or colour). If this is not possible perhaps bookmark it so you can refer to it often.

There are some illustrations and photographs on the Timeline of London sheet which you can cut out and stick on your timeline but it would be fantastic if you can draw some, or all of your own.

To start off your timeline rule a line along the bottom quarter of the sheet. Next make a perpendicular mark on this line where each date will go. You should allow roughly the same amount of space for each date.

Add as much information for each date as you can. You can research the topics you find most interesting and fill the sheet. You can work on individual sheets and then join them all together when you have finished. Make sure to keep the dates in the right order!
