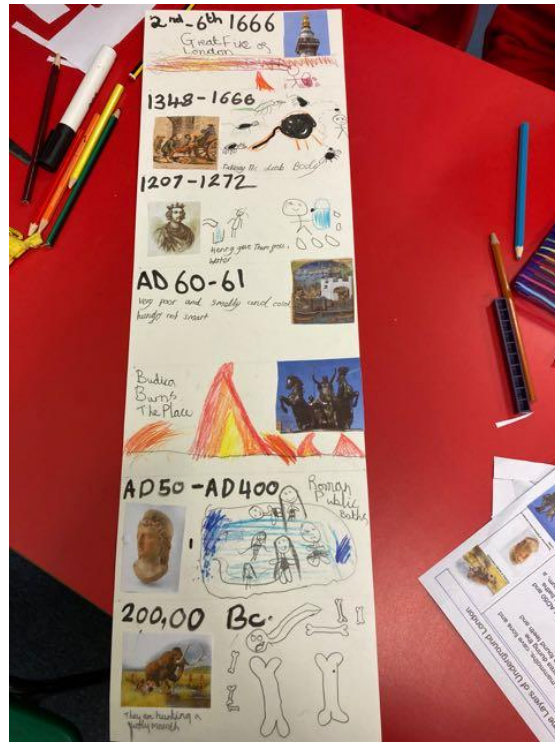
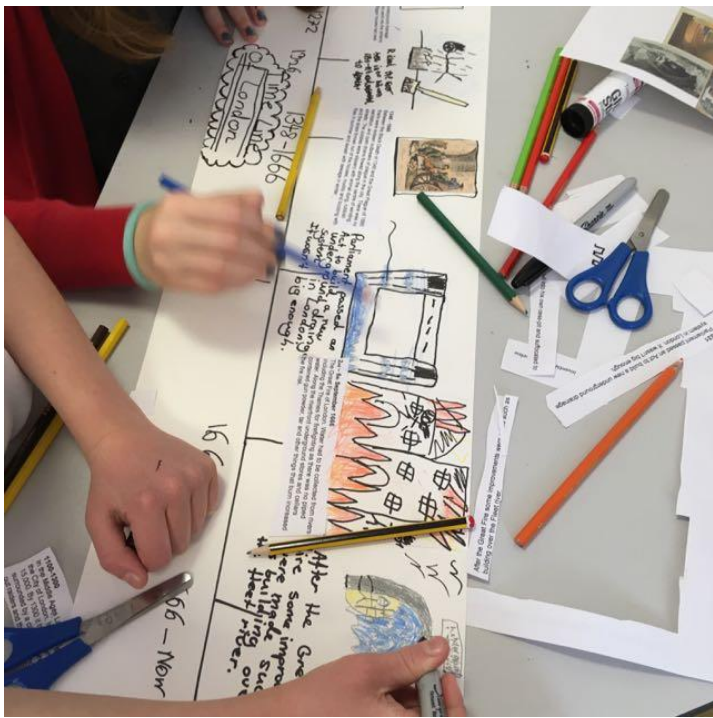




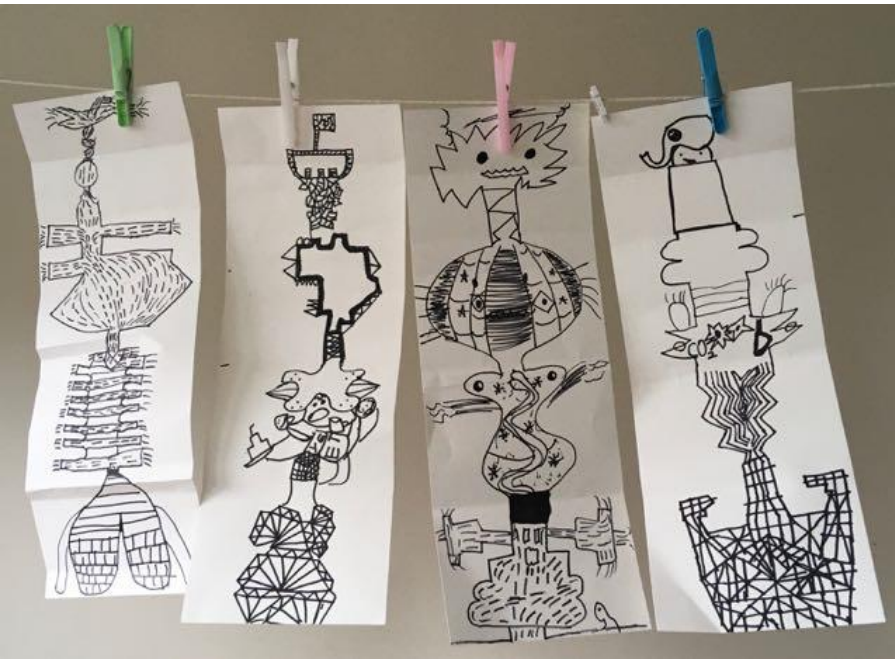
Session 1:
Underground/overground
drawings: Use the template
provided for the children to draw
in the underground services.
Point out the obelisk and
explain that it's a ventilation
shaft



Session 1:
Underground/overground collages: Help the children to work in pairs to make collages of the streetscape and underground including designing a ventilation shaft.



Session 2: Timelines work best on long strips of paper – they can be done either horizontally or vertically. Encourage children to divide the sheet up into the right number of sections first and to draw as well as using the pictures provided. See instructions provided.



Session 3: 'Ventequences' game for inspiration before starting on vent designs. See instructions provided.





Sessions 4/5: Model-making and presenting models to the class. Ask children to explain their ideas for their vent designs – what are they made of, where will the cold air enter and the hot air come out, what is special about them?
